NORTHROP GRUMMAN APPOINTS BERNARD P. CLARK TO
PROGRAM DIRECTOR FOR PUBLIC-PRIVATE INITIATIVES
AT NEWPORT NEWS SECTOR

NEWPORT NEWS, Va.—September 3, 2002 – Northrop Grumman Corporation (NYSE: NOC) announced today that its Newport News sector has appointed Bernard P. Clark to the position of program director, Public-Private Initiatives. In this position he will be responsible for strategic development and implementation of plans for workload requirements alignment, process and procedure benchmarking, and other public-private initiatives.

Clark will report to Irwin F. Edenzon, vice president, Business and Technology Development for Northrop Grumman Newport News.
