Northrop Grumman Celebrates 20 Years of Successful Holiday Food Drives

NEWPORT NEWS, Va. – Dec. 18, 2006 – Northrop Grumman Corporation’s (NYSE: NOC) Newport News sector, the United Steelworkers (Local 8888), the International Association of Fire Fighters (Local I-45) and the International Union, Security, Police, Fire Professionals of America (Local 451), joined together for the sector’s 20th annual holiday food drive.
